Last Time: Toronto rode a four-goal first period to a 7-2 win over Iowa on Saturday evening... Gerry Mayhew and Bradley Marek scored for the Wild... Carson Lambos and David Spacek each recorded two assists... The Marlies went 2-for-4 on the power play... Artur Akhtyamov turned aside 29-of-31 shots

Previous Season Series: Iowa and Toronto met twice during the 2014-15 season... The Marlies scored five goals in each game and won both meetings... Marc Hagel (1-1=2), Zack Mitchell (1-1=2), and Jonathon Blum (0-2=2) led Iowa in points... Greg McKegg scored four goals to pace Toronto scorers... Christopher Gibson started both games for the Marlies and allowed three goals

FOUR IN A PERIOD: Saturday's first period marked the first time since Feb. 9 (7-2 L at Manitoba) the Wild allowed four goals in a period... Iowa allowed four or more goals in a period six times during the 2024-25 season... The Wild last scored four goals in a period in the third period of a 5-1 win on Dec. 7, 2024 vs. Milwaukee

PLAY BY PERIOD: Saturday's contest marked the second consecutive game in which Iowa scored multiple goals in a period... The Wild dropped to 3-1-0 when scoring two or more goals in a period... Iowa has outshot opponents in four second periods in a row

SPECIAL TEAMS STATS: Iowa has not scored a power-play goal in three games in a row... The Wild have allowed power-play goals in four of the last five games after a six-game stretch of perfect penalty killing (19-for-19)

- Both Carson Lambos and David Spacek registered two assists in Saturday's game
- The two-point game was the first career two-point game for Lambos, who had previously recorded a point in 34 different games
- Spacek became the third Wild skater to record a multi-point game this season (Nicolas Aubé-Kubel [3], Gerry Mayhew [2])
- Spacek's two assists extended his team lead in points (9) and assists (9)

GERRY TIME

- Gerry Mayhew scored his team-leading sixth goal of the season in Saturday's game
- Mayhew has four points (2-2=4) in Iowa's last four games
- Mayhew has not gone more than two games without a point since his first game of the 2025-26 season on Oct. 24 at Texas
- The last time Mayhew went more than two games without a point in an Iowa uniform came over a three-game stretch from Nov. 30 - Dec. 5, 2018
